Tier 4 Visa and Immigration Requirement

In addition to the first year's tuition fees, when applying for a Tier 4 visa for Brunel University London, you must show you have living costs of £1,265 per month for each month of your course (to a maximum of 9 months, or £11,385).

If you have applied to live in on-campus accommodation, the maximum amount you may deduct from the living costs part of your visa application's Maintenance Requirement will now be £1,265.
